

# BYLAW NO. 2019-5

## WELL DRILLING LICENSE BYLAW

### **A Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Browning No. 34, in the Province of Saskatchewan, being a Bylaw to License Mining Contractors and Well Drilling Contractors**

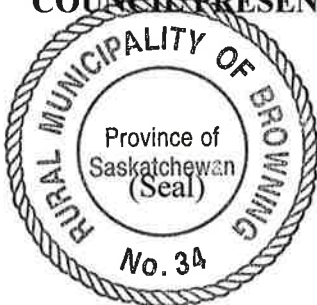
The Council of the Rural Municipality of Browning No. 34, in the Province of Saskatchewan, pursuant to Section 9 of *The Municipalities Act*, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this Bylaw, the word “contractor” shall include any person, firm or corporation.
2. Every well drilling contractor shall, before undertaking well drilling in the municipality, pay to the municipality the following license fee:
  - a. For the drilling of an oil well or a gas well four hundred and fifty (\$450.00) dollars;
  - b. For the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information two hundred and twenty-five (\$225.00) dollars.
- 3 Any contractor holding a license under this Bylaw shall produce and exhibit his license when required to do so by the license inspector, police officer, or other authorized person.
- 4 Bylaw No. 2006-8 is hereby repealed.
